In addition to the ready supply of spare parts, our customers value highly the individual tailored service offered by our technicians. This hotline service is available around the clock, all 365 days of the year.



## What drives us are ideas — you get the benefit



Bilge water separators in a particularly compact design. These units are very user-friendly and more than satisfy the regulations applying to oil separation.




